We are pleased to share our April bulletin with you.

Education

The Potter's Palace Christian School and our Junior High School wrote their end of second term examinations and vacated.

Our Senior High School and university students returned to the youth home for the Easter break.

We organized an Easter programme dubbed 'Easter Fest', where staff and children came together to celebrate the season with food, games and fellowship, creating a joyful and memorable atmosphere.

During our Guidance and Counselling sessions for the month, we focused on the topic of 'Gratitude', with emphasis on how to cultivate a thankful and positive mindset.



Health

Generally, all children are in good health.

However, three children attended their routine Child Welfare Clinic visits and one child was reviewed by an ENT specialist for an ear-related condition.

A group called Apeh Girls Foundation, engaged our adolescent girls in an interactive discussion on menstrual hygiene and reproductive health. We are grateful for the practical knowledge shared.



Staffing

Our teachers had an in-service training regarding documentation. The session focused on improving the preparation of children's report record keeping and other classroom-based documentation to support better tracking of each child's progress.

In addition, another staff member proceeded on maternity leave.



Other News

We held our monthly Thanksgiving and Anointing Service, to thank God for His numerous blessings during the month.

We also celebrated the birthdays of children and staff born in the month of April.

At the heart of our mission is the belief that every child deserves a family. In line with this and to also foster proper reintegration, five children went on vacation during the period.

We received 32 new children to the home this month. They were temporarily cared for under our support and have been successfully reunified with their families.

The unfinished structure above, which is intended to serve as a **Girls' Dormitory and Centre for Battered Women** is the building project we are focusing on currently. When completed, it will provide a safe and supportive space for our girls who are currently sleeping in a structure meant to serve as a clinic for the home. It will also serve as a shelter for women who go through different forms of abuse.

The next and very vital phase is the plastering and screeding. We remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.
