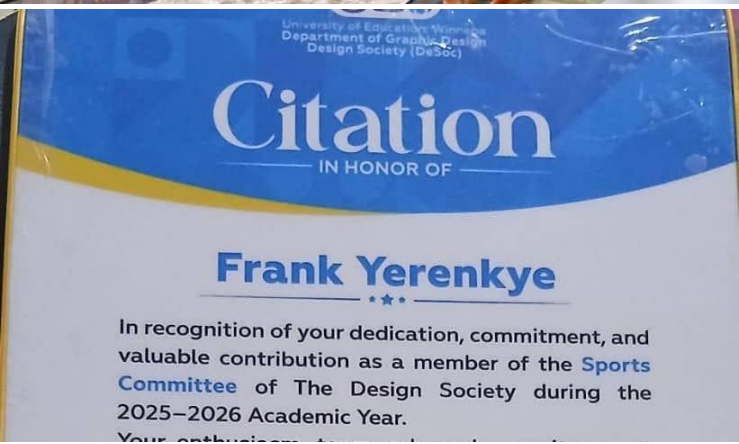
EDUCATION

Our summer programme came to a successful close this month. The programme, organised by our volunteer, Martina and her team, provided the children with an enriching and engaging experience during the long vacation.

To conclude the summer programme, the children participated in a debate on the topic: "Holistic development is a joint responsibility of children and authorities, not authorities alone." The children spoke with confidence, demonstrated impressive understanding of the topic and gave us much to be proud of.

We were also proud to celebrate one of our children who received a citation in recognition of his commitment and dedication as a member of the Sports Committee of the Graphic Design Society at the University of Education, Winneba.

Some of our children are having a music training with the GELP Foundation. They are learning to play instruments including the saxophone and trombone, giving them an opportunity to discover and develop their talents.





HEALTH

All our children are healthy.

During the month, four children received medical attention for various health concerns, including a skin reaction, waist pain, an orthopaedic condition and malaria. They were all taken to the hospital and received the necessary treatment and are doing well.

Two children also attended their routine Child Welfare Clinic appointments as part of our commitment to ensuring that their health needs are monitored regularly.



STAFFING

At the end of this academic year, the Executive Director held an evaluation meeting with our teachers to reflect on the term, assess our progress and identify areas where we can improve.

We were also pleased to welcome two volunteers who joined us to support our work and contribute their skills towards the development of the children.



OTHER NEWS

Five of our children had the opportunity to participate in the Dwell Camp, sponsored by TBL (The Blessed Life) Kids Ministry.

The experience provided them with opportunities for learning, fellowship and personal development.

We held our monthly Anointing and Thanksgiving Service, giving the children and staff an opportunity to come together in prayer and thanksgiving for God's faithfulness and protection.

We also celebrated the birthdays of children and staff born during the month of August.

This month, we welcomed a new child referred by the Department of Social Welfare and Community Development (DSWCD) into the home.

The unfinished structure above, which is intended to serve as a **Girls' Dormitory and Centre for Battered Women** is the building project we are focusing on currently. When completed, it will provide a safe and supportive space for our girls who are currently sleeping in a structure meant to serve as a clinic for the home. It will also serve as a shelter for women who go through different forms of abuse.

The next and very vital phase is the plastering and screeding. We remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.

We are grateful to all our partners, donors and friends who have contributed to enable us get this far and towards the purchasing of bags of cement. The cement was used for plastering the outside of the building. God bless you richly.
