Education

This month, The Potter's Palace Christian School held its Parent- Teacher Association (PTA) meeting as part of activities marking the end of the academic term. The meeting provided an opportunity for parents and teachers to discuss the academic progress and welfare of the children.

The pupils also sat for their end-of-term examinations. We appreciate their hard work and dedication throughout the term. In addition, during our end-of-month Thanksgiving and Anointing Service, a special celebration was held to honour pupils who successfully completed Kindergarten Two and Grade Six.

This month's Guidance and Counselling session focused on 'Pornography and Masturbation'. The discussion was conducted in an age-appropriate manner to educate the children on healthy values, self-discipline and responsible behaviour.

We were privileged to host a group called NOSACA Foundation, who organised a creative skills session for the children. They introduced the children to crocheting and taught them how to make various items such as hats and other handmade products. The session was both enjoyable and educational. We are grateful for their support which encourage creativity and skill development.





Staffing

We are pleased to announce that two volunteers joined our team this month to support our ongoing activities and programmes. We appreciate their willingness to contribute their time and skills to the work of the organisation.

Our Chief Executive Officer was invited to participate in the WASSA celebration organised by the Ghana Police Service and was represented by two staff members. We appreciate the invitation and the opportunity to strengthen relationships with stakeholders within the community.



Health

All our children are healthy.

During the month, thirteen children were treated for malaria, colds and coughs. All affected children received the necessary medical attention, and those taken to the hospital were treated and discharged.

Additionally, two children attended their routine Child Welfare Clinic, and one child attended her regular specialist clinic appointment.

In response to the nationwide sanitation exercise organised by the Government of Ghana, both the children and staff of the home actively participated in a clean-up exercise. This activity promoted environmental cleanliness and community participation.



Founder's Day



This month, we held a special service to celebrate Founder's Day, observed annually on the birthday of our Founder, Dr. Mrs. Jane Irina Adu (Mama Jane), in honour of her vision and legacy, and to thank God for His blessings.

For her special concern and love for women, a talk on 'Parenting' was organised for some women in the community.

The session was facilitated by Mr. Peter Amos Tweneboah- Kodua, former Deputy National Director of the Department of Social Welfare, who shared valuable insights on parenting, family care and the important role women play in building strong and healthy communities.

As part of the celebration, we also donated assorted items and a token amount to support the women.
