Education

The Potter's Palace Christian School organised an exciting Spelling Bee and Reading Competition, providing learners with an opportunity to demonstrate their literacy skills and build confidence.

The school also held its Sport's Day this month. The event was engaging as students showcased their abilities and had fun.

A team from Bourse Jackie visited our girls to facilitate a session on Menstrual Hygiene Management. The discussion equipped participants with valuable knowledge on personal hygiene, self-care and menstrual health. The team also generously donated sanitary pads to support the girls.

This month's Guidance and Counselling Sessions focused on 'Bullying Awareness and Prevention'. Discussions centred on promoting kindness and healthy relationships, while encouraging children to speak up against bullying to create a safe environment.

We are also delighted to share that nineteen students under our educational support programme successfully completed their West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASSCE). We congratulate them on reaching this important milestone and wish them success in their future endeavours. We are thankful to all our donors and friends for their unwavering support and commitment to transforming the lives of these beneficiaries.



Staffing

Our staff members participated in a training session themed "Adding Value to The Potter's Village at 26- My Stake."

The session encouraged effective service delivery, teamwork, professionalism and the important role each staff member plays in advancing the vision and mission of the organisation.

Our headteacher also attended a retreat organised by Ghana Education Service of the Shai- Osudoku District. The purpose of the retreat was to discuss key issues concerning teaching and learning, share best practices and strategise for improved educational outcomes within the district.



Health

All our children are healthy.

During the month, some children were treated of cold and coughs, three received tetanus vaccinations following minor injuries.

Two other children attended their scheduled Child Welfare Clinic appointments.

Additionally, one attended her monthly Sickling Clinic review to ensure her continued health.



Other News

We held our regular Anointing and Thanksgiving Service, to gather in worship, prayer and thanksgiving to God for His faithfulness and protection throughout the month and for the first half of the year.

We were also delighted to welcome Bake Me a Smile (Baker's Galaxy), who celebrated the birthdays of our June-born children by sharing moments of joy and presenting them with thoughtful gift items.

Our team undertook a community outreach programme at Asebi (a town near Ayikuma), where we ministered to vulnerable families.

The outreach included the sharing of the Gospel and the distribution of essential items to beneficiaries. The recipients expressed heartfelt appreciation for the support and fellowship shared during the visit.

We want specially thank our POVI Family who are particularly interested in our Community Outreach Programs. Thank you for supporting us to reach out to vulnerable families. Through your generosity and partnership, lives continue to be impacted and communities are transformed.

The next and very vital phase is the plastering and screeding. We remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.
