EDUCATION



In celebration of Ghana's Independence Day, The Potter's Palace Christian School organised a vibrant Food Durbar with support from Herbalife Family Foundation. The highlight of the event was a friendly inter-section competition where pupils prepared and presented a variety of local dishes, showcasing teamwork and cultural appreciation. The celebration also featured a brief marching display to mark the significance of the day.

This month, we facilitated National Health Insurance registrations for newly admitted children on our Community Support Program.

Two of our children received treatment at the hospital for an infection and malaria.

We also had nurses from the Dodowa CHPS compound, who visited the home to administer Vitamin D supplements to the children, contributing to their overall health and well-being.

The Executive Director was invited to a national programme organized by the Ministry of Gender, Children and Social Protection in commemoration of International Women's Day. The event, held under the theme "Rights, Equality and Empowerment: Action for All Women and Girls", focused on celebrating the contributions of women to national development and included the launch of the National Gender Policy (2025–2034).

Our teaching staff participated in a workshop which focused on curriculum development and lesson-note preparation. The session was facilitated by the GES Shai Osu-Doku District officers.

We are pleased to welcome one new intern to the team this month.

To promote cultural awareness and storytelling traditions, we organised 'By the Fireside', where the children listened to stories and performed short dramas. This initiative was designed to promote mental wellness among our children and help them appreciate life before the advent of modern technology such as mobile phones and television.

As part of our ongoing commitment to supporting vulnerable individuals in our community, we were able to extend assistance to a young man living with a physical disability. He has been under our care and we are grateful to all those who support us to respond to the needs of others.

Some of our children were delighted to receive visits from their family members, which provided emotional encouragement and strengthened family bonds.

We extend our appreciation to Baker's Galaxy for celebrating children born in March with a special birthday treat, bringing joy and excitement to the home.

Our Monthly Thanksgiving and Anointing Service was held successfully to express gratitude to God. We also celebrated the birthdays of Staff and Children born in the month of March.

The unfinished structure above, which is intended to serve as a **Girls' Dormitory and Centre for Battered Women** is the building project we are focusing on currently. When completed, it will provide a safe and supportive space for our girls who are currently sleeping in a structure meant to serve as a clinic for the home. It will also serve as a shelter for women who go through different forms of abuse.

The next and very vital phase is the decking and we remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.
