Education



We are deeply grateful to our Partners, Donors and Friends for your continued support and prayers. We are pleased to share some highlights from the month of May and the impact your support continues to make in the lives of the children, youth and women we serve.

The month began with the reopening of schools. Our children in basic school, senior high school and tertiary institutions successfully returned to their respective schools with the necessary educational support provided through the generosity of our donors and partners.

As part of our regular Guidance and Counseling Sessions, we discussed 'Sexually Transmitted Diseases', focusing on awareness, prevention and making informed life choices.

At Potter's Palace Christian School, the academic term commenced with a Parent Association meeting, providing an opportunity for parents, guardians and staff to discuss plans and expectations for the term and strengthen collaboration in supporting the children's education.

The school was also privileged to host Hope and Empowerment Foundation GH LBG to conduct a 'Mindset Development Training' for our pupils. The session encouraged the children to develop positive attitudes, build confidence and cultivate habits that will help them succeed academically and personally.



Staffing

We were delighted to welcome one intern and two volunteers who joined our team during the month. Their presence and support contributed positively to our daily activities and programs.

Our teaching staff also participated in an in-service training session on 'Classroom Management' aimed at enhancing professional skills and strengthening the quality of education provided to our children.

Health

We are pleased to report that all our children remained generally healthy throughout the month.

A few children experienced mild colds and received prompt treatment and care.

Additionally, two of our younger children attended their routine Child Welfare Clinic appointments and are progressing well.

We thank God for His protection and good health over all the children.



Other News

During the month, we celebrated the birthday of our Executive Director. We also had the pleasure of having Baker's Galaxy celebrating all our children born in May, bringing smiles and joy.

We organised a session under our Youth Empowerment Initiative. This program serves young adults who grew up within our care and have transitioned into our youth home and those we continue to support in various communities. The session was on Mastering Time & Priorities, it was conducted by a Senior lecturer from the University of Ghana, Dr. Saviour Nubuor, equipping them with practical skills to help them prepare for independent and productive futures.

We extend our sincere appreciation to everyone who contributed towards our recent appeal for towels, sponges and underwear. The donated items were distributed to the children.

As part of our ongoing efforts to empower women and support single mothers, we organised a skills training program in partnership with Grace Family Child and Aged Foundation on 'Fascinator Making'. Participants learned practical techniques that can help generate income and create sustainable livelihood opportunities. Our goal is to support outstanding participants with startup assistance, enabling them to establish small businesses and improve their economic independence.

We were privileged to attend the Educational Impact and Workforce Innovation Symposium organized by the Grace Compassion Global Foundation and T. D. Jakes foundation. During the event, The Potter's Village received the Grace Compassion Economic Empowerment Award in recognition of our efforts to empower vulnerable children, families and communities. We are thankful for this honor and for the support that makes our work possible.

For 26 years, your partnership has helped us provide shelter, education, family support and hope to countless children and families across our communities.

This month, The Potter's Village turned 26 years, in view of this we had a special Thanksgiving and Anointing Service to reflect on God's faithfulness and the many lives that have been transformed over the years through the support of our partners and friends.

When completed, it will provide a safe and supportive space for our girls who are currently sleeping in a structure meant to serve as a clinic for the home. It will also serve as a shelter for women who go through different forms of abuse.

The next and very vital phase is the plastering and screeding. We remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.
