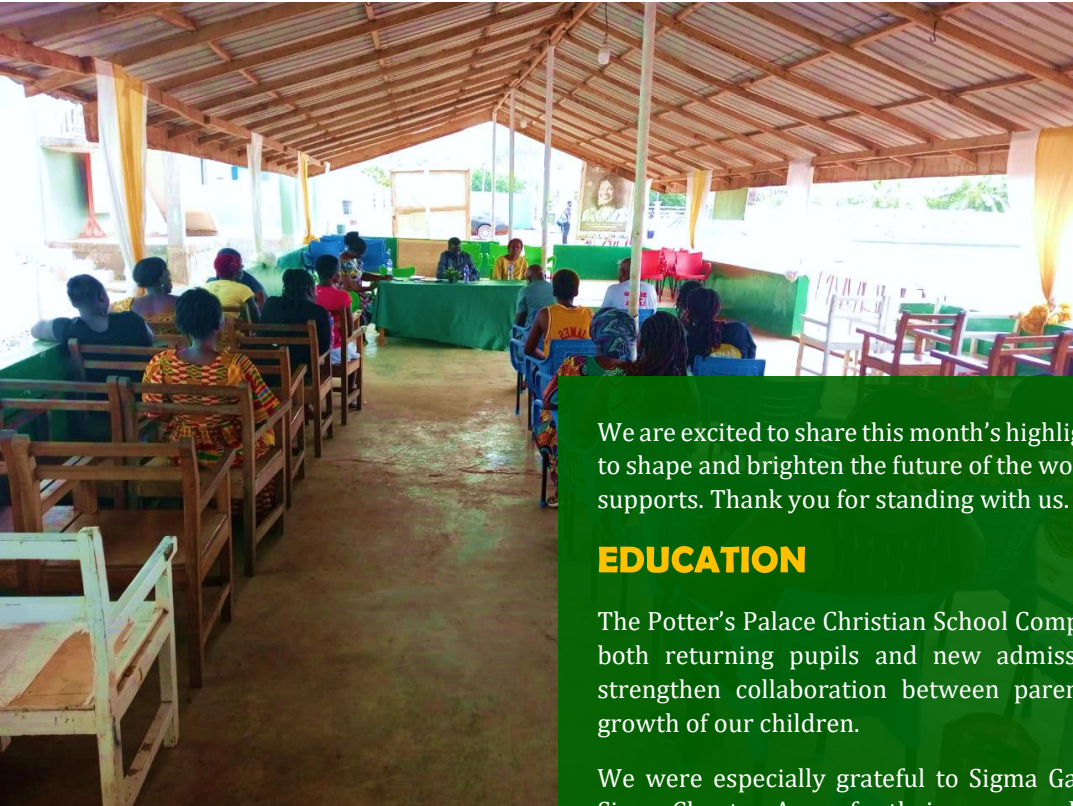

EDUCATION

The Potter's Palace Christian School Complex reopened this month, welcoming both returning pupils and new admissions. A PTA meeting was held to strengthen collaboration between parents and teachers for the continued growth of our children.

We were especially grateful to Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Inc., Nu Lambda Sigma Chapter, Accra, for their generous donation of 80 school uniforms, which will allow pupils to attend school with much joy.

We are also proud to celebrate one of our own, now studying at the University of Education, Winneba, who received the Design Society Achievement Award for Male Sports Personality of the Year 2025; a shining example of the greatness within our children.





HEALTH

This month, our younger children were dewormed.

TBL Kids, in collaboration with Swells and Swells LBG, conducted blood group and genotype screenings. They also provided consultations with doctors and nutritionists.

Routine child welfare clinic visits continued for our children, including the baby, ensuring proper growth monitoring.

In addition, minor skin infections reported among some children were promptly treated.



STAFFING

Our teachers benefited from an in-service training on 'Effective Teaching Methods', gaining new skills to strengthen classroom delivery.

Our caregivers underwent the district's health and safety screening, certifying them to cook and care for the children.



OTHER NEWS

The Child and Family Welfare division under the Department of social welfare and Community Development conducted an ad hoc inspection of our premises this month.

We successfully reunified two children with their families, reinforcing the importance of family bonds in a child's growth and wellbeing.

We also celebrate the journey of one of our young beneficiaries, who has transitioned into independent living. With no known family to support, he has been set up with his own accommodation and is pursuing carpentry training as a pathway to self-reliance. This is a long-term commitment to childcare and empowerment. We are grateful to all our friends and donors who support us to touch lives.

This month, we joyfully celebrated our 25th Anniversary. The event featured inspiring children's performances, heartfelt speeches, and fundraising towards the Legacy Project; the Girls' Dormitory and Centre for Battered Women. PROJECT 2025

The unfinished structure above, which is intended to serve as a **Girls' Dormitory and Centre for Battered Women** is the building project we are focusing on this year. When completed, it will provide a safe and supportive space for our girls who are currently sleeping in a structure meant to serve as a clinic for the home. It will also serve as a shelter for women who go through different forms of abuse.

By the grace of God and with the generous support of our donors, we have successfully completed the foundational and pillar reinforcements. The block work to the lintel level is also completed.

The next and very vital phase is the decking and we remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.
