EDUCATION

This month, our Guidance and Counseling sessions focused on emotional development, encouraging confidence and healthy self-expression.

We are pleased to share that one of our past beneficiaries who completed a Physician Assistantship program under our care, has now gained admission to study Law at the University of Cape Coast. We supported him with food items as he begins this new chapter. We are grateful to see a young person we have nurtured grow into an independent adult who is able to return to school and support himself.

Also, three of our beneficiaries graduated from the University of Education, Winneba in their respective fields. We are grateful to Panbros Salt Industries Limited, Thermotech Engineering and Projects Limited and all our donors for helping them reach this milestone.

HEALTH

All our children are healthy. This month, one of our children experienced a sickle cell crisis, where she had a lot of boils on her skin. She was taken to the hospital and treated.

Two others were treated for malaria at the hospital and another received rabies vaccination following a

Another attended the Ghana National Association of Private Schools meeting to engage in discussions on improving academic administration and quality amongst private schools and the National Schools Inspectorate authority.

We supported a brilliant but needy student with items to go to school.

One of our major donors contributed to our women empowerment efforts by providing assorted fabric materials to help a single mother start her business.

In addition, we conducted a home studying visit for four children living with their grandmother and great grandmother, ensuring their welfare and needs are properly assessed.

Faith Overcomes All

Ours is a story of faith.

Ours is a testimony of unwavering belief that God is able to do all things. We believe that Jesus Christ is indeed a 'Show Master', and He delights in revealing His power in the most remarkable ways.

Mama Jane once received a woman whose situation seemed impossible. She arrived at our shelter with a severe wound on her leg, one that stubbornly refused to heal. Her husband and family had rejected her, for she could not remain in the home because of the constant bleeding and smell from the wound. She had nowhere to go and no one to help, until someone referred her to The Potter's Village.

She was taken to the hospital repeatedly, yet every medical attempt failed. The wound lived on, but her hope was dying. So, Mama Jane began to do what she knew best: to pray. With dedication, she anointed this woman and prayed over her day after day.

The woman wore long dresses that covered her entire leg because this wound. To outsiders, it may have appeared to be her modest fashion choice. But within the shelter, it was understood that beneath those long garments were hidden her pain, her struggle and her shame.

Then one day, as she walked, she felt her skirt catch on something. When we tried to free the fabric, something extraordinary happened. As the cloth pulled away, it drew out from her leg a piece of bone that had been trapped deep within the wound. It was in that moment that her healing began. The wound that would not die finally started closing. Her hope was revived.

It will also serve as a shelter for women who go through different forms of abuse.

The next and very vital phase is the decking and we remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.
