## Education

During the month, pupils of The Potter's Palace Christian School successfully wrote their end of term examinations and proceeded on vacation. The school also held its Carols Service, which provided a meaningful time reflection on the birth of Christ.

Two out of our six children who completed the tertiary in the year 2025, graduated from Koforidua Technical University. One of the graduates, who completed a diploma programme with excellent academic performance, was awarded a scholarship to continue his studies at the degree level.

We thank God for these achievements and we are grateful to Thermotech Engineering and Projects Limited for their support and to all our cherished friends who have helped them come this far.

Our Guidance and Counseling Session for this month focused on 'Obedience and Responsibility Towards Work'.





## Health

All our children are healthy. One of them attended her routine sickle cell check up at the clinic. Another was hospitalised and treated for malaria during the month.

In addition, a number of children experienced mumps. All affected children received appropriate treatment and are currently in stable condition.



## Staffing

We were blessed to receive volunteers who supported and educated our children, contributing positively to their learning and overall development.

Our National Service Personnel for the previous year successfully completed her service and exited. We appreciate her service and contribution to our work.

We have also received a new service person, who is providing valuable support to our operations.







## Other News

We held a Thanksgiving and Anointing Service to express our gratitude to God for His protection, provision and faithfulness throughout the year.

Our partners from Herbalife Family Foundation paid a familiarisation visit to the home. They discussed the way forward, explored how they can further support our mission and donated to us.

Mr. Bismark Baidoo and his family dedicated a new chapel at the home, which was officially unveiled this month. We are deeply grateful for his generosity.

The Department of Social Welfare and Community Development came to the home for a monitoring exercise.

At the heart of our mission is the belief that every child deserves the warmth and stability of a family. In line with this, we had family visitations, which served as a time of connection and emotional support for both the children and their families.

## PROJECT 2025

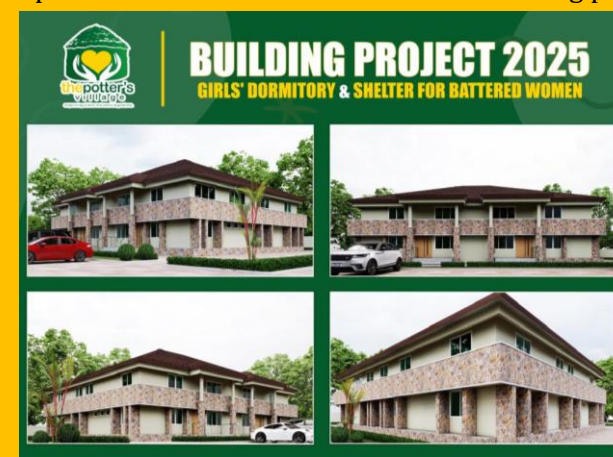

When completed, it will provide a safe and supportive space for our girls who are currently sleeping in a structure meant to serve as a clinic for the home. It will also serve as a shelter for women who go through different forms of abuse.

The next and very vital phase is the decking and we remain hopeful and committed as we continue this important work.
