

## EDUCATION

As part of our holistic development approach, this month's Guidance and Counseling Sessions focused on 'Peer Pressure'. All our children are healthy.

This month we organised an aerobic exercise session for both staff and children. This was sponsored by Herbalife Family Foundation. The session was fun and engaging.

In addition, one child attended a routine monthly check up at the Sickle Cell Clinic. Another child was admitted and treated for malaria. A few other children experienced common colds and were treated promptly.



## STAFFING

We organised a staff training session centered on 'The Right Mindset for Growth' and 'The Importance of Preparation for Success'. The training encouraged continuous learning, teamwork and intentional personal development, equipping staff to serve with better effectiveness.



Two new caregivers were also employed during the month to support the daily care and supervision of the children.




## OTHER NEWS

## PROJECT 2026


